Cllr Witham was elected as the SALC Representative.

7. Election of Village Hall & Community Council Representative

Cllr Goodman was elected as the VH&CC Representative.

8. Minutes of the meeting held on 14/03/23

The minutes of the meeting held on 14/03/23 were approved and signed by the Chairman as a true record.

9. Matters Arising directly from the Minutes

- Letters have been sent out to Landowners, Stables and Horse owners. It was stated that horse owners have had a meeting and can confirm that none of those in the village had been riding on or near footpaths and all have a vested interest in safety. It was found difficult to source appropriate notices to put on footpath signs.
- > The Chairman has approached the owners of two properties to request that their overgrown hedges are cut back. Both have agreed and this will be done in the Autumn.

13. <u>Planning Application: DC/23/01708 The Lilacs Nedging Road IP7 7HW – Submission of Details (reserved Matters) following Outline Planning Permission DC/20/02405. Access, Appearance, Landscaping, Layout and Scale to be considered for 1no dwelling and detached garage.</u>

The Council and three neighbours present at the meeting agreed that the newly submitted design was more appropriate than the refused proposal, but of scale too large for the site.

The proposal would unacceptably damage the aspects of nearby properties and the general public. It was agreed that a revised proposal in accord with the outline planning approval, for a two bedroom bungalow and similar to the dwelling proposed for the site to the west of The Lilacs could be acceptable.
