Following an Extraordinary Parish Council Meeting on 10th October 2022, the Parish Council has no objection to this application but is concerned at the size/nature of the proposed building and the intrusion into agricultural land.

The appearance of the exterior has changed significantly from the bungalow shown on the illustration DC/20/02405, which was granted outline permission for the development of the site. The proposed extension of the garden into the field beyond the original boundary encroaches into what is currently designated agricultural land. In the Planning Statement, under the Item Ownership Certificates and Agricultural Land Declaration, in answer to the question 'Is any of the land to which the application relates part of an Agricultural Holding?' the applicant has ticked the NO box. This would not appear to be correct at the date of this application.

On the site drawing as now presented, the dwelling appears to extend into this extended area. The original proposal DC/20/02405 and permission subsequently granted showed the rear of the plot to be in line with the existing boundary.

8. Any Other Planning Applications Received

No other planning applications have been received.

9. Insurance Renewal/Asset Register
