

**Minutes of Nedging-with-Naughton Parish Council Meeting**

Cllr Lindsay confirmed that he is aware of the history surrounding the Wallow Lane junction and the quest to extend the 30 mph speed limit, which he is happy to support.

A member of the public raised concerns, regarding the buses and also street parking in Bildeston.

Cllr Lindsay indicated that any concerns would need to be raised by Bildeston Parish Council.

**District Cllr Alan Ferguson** read his report to the meeting (see attached).

Questions were raised regarding the reduction of 43 wards to 31. Cllr Ferguson confirmed that there has been a huge amount of development and change and that the Chief Executive's decision has been accepted so Councillors will need to be re-structured around the 31 wards.
