

**Minutes of Nedging-with-Naughton Parish Council Meeting

There was a discussion regarding the cutting of the verges. The chairman confirmed that the Landowners were responsible for the cutting of hedges and Highways are responsible for overgrown footpaths/roads. All complaints should be recorded on the SCC web site and it has been proved in the past that this can be effective.

Any concerns regarding the posts that have been put in at the roadside of a listed property in Taylors Lane, should be reported on the SCC website.

There will no longer be grit piles on the side of the roads due to the damage that the salt causes. Yellow grit bins can still be used and any extra bins required will need to be ordered and purchased by the Parish Council.

There are still concerns with regard to where the 40mph speed limit starts. County Councillor Robert Lindsay confirmed that the decision had already been made by the speed limit panel and this is unlikely to be changed.

ICO Registration – Further enquiries were made with SALC, who advised that the Parish Council is a Data Controller and ICO registration is not optional and the data protection fee should be paid. The fee goes to their operation to help maintain high standards of data protection and the freedom of information requirements. They regulate the whole system and provide advice, guidance and enforce breaches. Non-payment could result in a fine for not complying with the law. It was agreed via e mails to go ahead and register with ICO and pay the fee.

It has also been agreed to pay the £40 fee by an annual direct debit which then reduces the fee to £35.
