

**Minutes of Nedging-with-Naughton Parish Council Meeting**

**7. Planning Application DC/18/04184 Underwood Grange, Ipswich Road, Nedging With Naughton, Ipswich Suffolk IP7 7DA - Application for Listed Building Consent. Erection of a garden room extension. New timber staircase inserted at first floor to loft. Internal alterations as per Design and Access Statement**

The Council have no objections to this planning application.

**8. Planning Application DC/18/04289 - Location: Land Opposite Tye Farm , Ipswich Road, Nedging with Naughton, Ipswich IP7 7BN - Erection of a 4 bed detached dwelling, garage and creation of a new single vehicular access**

The Parish Council oppose the application. The site is prominent in the Village and the little used barn is unattractive and detracts from the overall impression of the area. The existing approved Planning Application for the site offered an acceptable improvement. The new Application for a 4 bedroom house in lieu of a 3 bedroom bungalow, although of a design which would be compatible with the surrounding development, is considerably larger and appears to be too close to the existing clay block building which has been previously proposed to be preserved. The site needs to be considered in its entirety and there is insufficient detail provided to allow approval of the new application as presented to date. The new access onto the Ipswich Road has not been justified and the parking proposal appears to be inadequate.

### **13. Clerk's Report**

There will be a second customer access point pop-up at Hadleigh Library. Council staff will be on hand once a week to offer local residents the opportunity to meet fact to face. There will also be a permanent iPad for customers to use anytime during the library's opening hours to access online services. The pop-up opens on Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> October and will run for three months on a Thursday afternoon from 1.30 – 5 pm.

Telec Networks on Behalf of BT Openreach – have issued a road closure planned on IPSWICH ROAD NEDGING WITH NAUGHTON. A letter will be delivered to all local residence and businesses within closure and surrounding roads. There is an awareness that that this is going to affect a lot of people and the need to try to minimise as much disturbance as possible. Works are scheduled for 2 days only, 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> December between 9.30 and 15.30.

The 40mph speed limit extension has now been approved. There is normally a need to book road works three months in advance, unless they can tie them in with some road works already agreed. This means that it will not be done until the new year.

A draft Precept will be drawn up for consideration at the next meeting in January 2019.
