Maintenance

The building of the extension has recommenced and the walls are now up.

We have now had 3 quotes for the landscaping behind the hall – to put in a patio area and clear the overgrown bushes. The work on this can now start.

We had an email regarding the side gate into the playing field by a disabled person. Something we have never had before. The access is too narrow and the outside step is in the way. We will make a decision shortly about the fence, but we intend to put in a new access as soon as possible.

The hall now has a regular cleaner going in once every 4 weeks at the moment but we may increase that to once every 2 weeks due to the amount of use the hall is now getting.

Activities

The hall is being used most days now. I have enclosed a time table of events below. But Tai Chi has now started on a Monday lunch time. The dog training class is running 2 classes on a Monday evening. Pilates and keep fit are going well and the monthly coffee morning has been well attended I understand.
